## POST-TRIAL PROCEDURE

**6.4.1.** <u>Motion for New Trial</u>. A motion for a new trial to be held in the trial court may be made by the defendant within seven (7) days after judgment. The Court shall grant a motion for a new trial for the causes set forth in §3.8.25, if such trial is required in the interest of justice. (Prior code Ch. III, Art. III, §5)

**6.4.2.** <u>Right of Appeal</u>. After imposing sentence in a case which has gone to trial on a plea of not guilty, the Court shall advise the defendant of his or her right of appeal. All appeals shall be made in accordance with this code. (Prior code Ch. III, Art. III, §6)
