ABUSE OF OFFICE

7.15.1 Official Misconduct.

7.15.1. Official Misconduct. (a) A public servant is guilty of official misconduct if with intent to obtain a benefit or to deprive another person of a lawful right or privilege:

(1) He or she intentionally commits an unauthorized act under color of law;
or

(2) He or she intentionally refrains from performing a duty imposed upon him or her by law.

(b) Official misconduct is a gross misdemeanor. (Res. 93-025 (part), passed Mar. 8, 1993)
