CONTRIBUTING TO THE CRIMINAL ACT OF A MINOR

- **7.27.1.** Contributing to the Criminal Act of a Minor. (a) Any person who, by act or omission, knowingly encourages, causes, or contributes to the criminal act of a person under eighteen (18) years of age shall be guilty of a gross misdemeanor.
- (b) Contributing to the criminal act of a minor is a gross misdemeanor. (Res. 93-025 (part), passed Mar. 8, 1993)
- **7.27.2.** Contributing to the Delinquency of a Child. Any person who shall, by an action or omission, willfully encourage or contribute to the delinquency of any child under eighteen (18) years of age shall be guilty of an offense and upon conviction thereof shall be sentenced to confinement for a period of not more than four (4) months or to pay a fine of not more than three hundred and sixty dollars (\$360) or both, with costs.
