## CONSTRUCTION; EFFECTIVE DATE; AMENDMENTS

**7.33.1.** <u>Construction</u>. In interpreting the provisions of this title, the Court shall first look for guidance to the written laws of the Suquamish Tribe, the decisions of the Tribal Court, and the customs and traditions of the Suquamish people. The Court may then consider the laws and customs of other jurisdictions but shall not be bound by them. (Res. 93-025 (part), passed Mar. 8, 1993)

**7.33.2.** <u>Effective Date</u>. The effective date of this code shall be March 8, 1993. This code shall continue in effect until the Tribal Council of the Suquamish Tribe supersedes it. (Res. 93-025 (part), passed Mar. 8, 1993)

**7.33.3.** <u>Amendments</u>. Amendments to this title may be made by resolution of the Suquamish Tribal Council. (Res. 93-025 (part), passed Mar. 8, 1993)
