9.4.1. Jurisdiction. The Suquamish Tribal Court shall have the authority to change the name of any person upon petition of such person or upon the petition of the parents of any minor. A fee shall be charged as appropriate to the situation. (Prior code Ch. V, Art. V, §1 (part))

9.4.2. Records. Any order issued by the Court for change of name shall be kept as a permanent record, and copies shall be filed with the Suquamish Tribe, the Bureau of Indian Affairs, and the Bureau of Vital Statistics of the State of Washington. (Prior code Ch. V, Art. V, §1 (part))
