**Rules and Regulations:**

1. In general, no vehicles will be allowed in the vendor area, except to load and unload. Space is limited, so we all need to share.
2. You must provide your own booth, tables, chairs, extension cords, etc. and set up within the marked areas (10x10). Those wanting more space will be charged another booth space, subject to availability. Generators will be allowed on a case-by case basis (depending usually on noise/annoyance level). You are required to clean up after yourselves.
3. A completed application form and fees are due **BEFORE** sales begin and **BEFORE** set up. No set up will be allowed before 9AM Friday August 17th, 2018.
4. No toys resembling weapons, No Flying, string shooting or any sticky type toys are to be sold at this celebration. Your cooperation in this will be appreciated.
5. The Chief Seattle Day's committee will be the only seller of "Pop" or "Indian Baked Salmon", so please don't sell or offer these items at no cost. (Contact coordinator for clarification)
6. The Event Coordinator for this year is Ed Midkiff, who will have final authority on decisions involving Chief Seattle Days. Booth permits may be denied or revoked if such a permit will be deemed detrimental, harmful, or inappropriate to the Celebration.
7. NO drugs or alcohol are allowed on the Celebration Grounds.
8. **Do not extend or place items outside your area. Talk to coordinator for clarification**
9. **Chief Seattle Days or the Suquamish Tribe will not be liable for any accidents, injuries, or losses, which may occur.**

**10. IMPORTANT NOTES:**

Participating U.S. Tribes & Canadian Nations will have first priority in vendor selection.

The CSD committee does not rent canopies, tables, chairs; skirting, etc. vendors must meet all requirements established by the Suquamish Tribe Health District (Bob Alexander), Kitsap County Fire Marshal Office & Suquamish tribal police.

**Please remember you are required to keep your area clean at all times (i.e.) no empty boxes or trash laying around any violators will be asked to leave and will forfeit booth fee. And will be billed for any cost we accrue in clean up.**
