- **3.1.1.** <u>Power Vested</u>. The judicial power of the people of the Port Madison Indian Reservation is vested in the Suquamish Tribal Courts. (Prior code Ch. I, Art. I, §1)

- **3.1.3.** Court of Appeals. The Suquamish Tribal Court of Appeals will operate in accordance with Chapter 3.4. (Prior code Ch. I, Art. II, §1 and Art. IV, §5; amended by Res. 89-007 (part), passed Jan. 17, 1989; amended by Res. 2022-011, passed February 7, 2022)
