3.1.1. Power Vested. The judicial power of the people of the Port Madison Indian Reservation is vested in the Suquamish Tribal Courts. (Prior code Ch. I, Art. I, §1)

3.1.2. Trial Court. The trial court of the Suquamish Tribal Court will consist of one (1) chief judge and one (1) or more associate judges. (Prior code Ch. I, Art. III, §1; amended by Res. 91-017 §1, passed Mar. 11, 1991)

3.1.3. Court of Appeals. The Suquamish Tribal Court of Appeals will operate in accordance with Chapter 3.4. (Prior code Ch. I, Art. II, §1 and Art. IV, §5; amended by Res. 89-007 (part), passed Jan. 17, 1989; amended by Res. 2022-011, passed February 7, 2022)
