The SUN-FRI schedule will continue EACH WEEK until further notice

RESTRICTIONS:

- 1) ONE DRIFT NET PER FISHER PER BOAT; 2 set nets per skiff
- 2) REMAINS CLOSED OUTSIDE A LINE FROM PIER 91 TO THE LIGHT AT THE DUWAMISH HEAD
- 3) CLOSED UPSTREAM OF SPOKANE STREET BRIDGE
