### **FISHING SCHEDULE:**

OPEN: 8:00 AM Tuesday, November 7, 2023 CLOSES: 8:00 AM Friday, November 10, 2023

### **RESTRICTIONS:**

Fishermen must be present while working their gear and work with the tidal exchanges. A ½ mile ft radius closure around the mouth of Grover's Creek shall remain in effect. Release all live Chinook and wild coho salmon. Collection limited to between 100-200 Chum salmon.

## **AREA RESTRICTIONS:**

The Bay will remain closed to fishing where it begins to constrict north of a line from a long concreted bulkhead on the Miller Bay Rd side (look for the large Yellow house) eastward to a large rock wall bulkhead with a pipe extending from the northern end.
