**CATCH AREAS:** Marine Bottomfish/Shellfish Areas: 26B, 26C

**LEGAL GEAR:** Hook and Line (no more than two rods per fisher);  
Beach Seines – 600 ft max. length  
Gillnets: max mesh of 1 inches

**FISHING SCHEDULE:** 6:00 AM January 4, 2024  
11:59 PM December 31, 2024

**OTHER RESTRICTIONS:**

1. Release all WILD steelhead UNHARMED (if possible)
2. All provisions of Title 14 (Suquamish Fishing Ordinance) apply
3. Fishers should report ALL marine mammal encounters
4. New additional net identification marking is now required: Set nets: every tenth cork shall be labeled with the fisher's ID number; Drift nets: Every 100<sup>th</sup> cork or float shall be labeled with the fisher's ID number.
