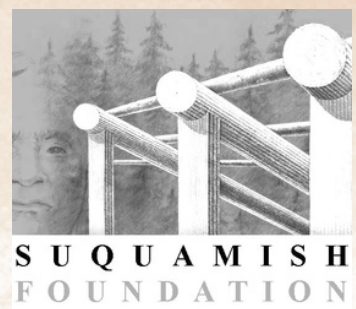

Regular vaccination clinics, covid testing and completing construction of the Suquamish Tribe's first medical clinic. Chief Seattle Days was celebrated by Tribal families with the traditional salmon bake and togetherness, that had been sorely missed. Finally, the holiday season brought a chance to partner with Port Madison Enterprises for a Holiday Lights Festival at the Resort, kicked off with a magical treelighting.

As we look forward to 2023, we will be offering some community concerts at the House of Awakened Culture, a fun collaboration with the Bainbridge Island Museum of Art and an exciting indigenous youth exchange program.

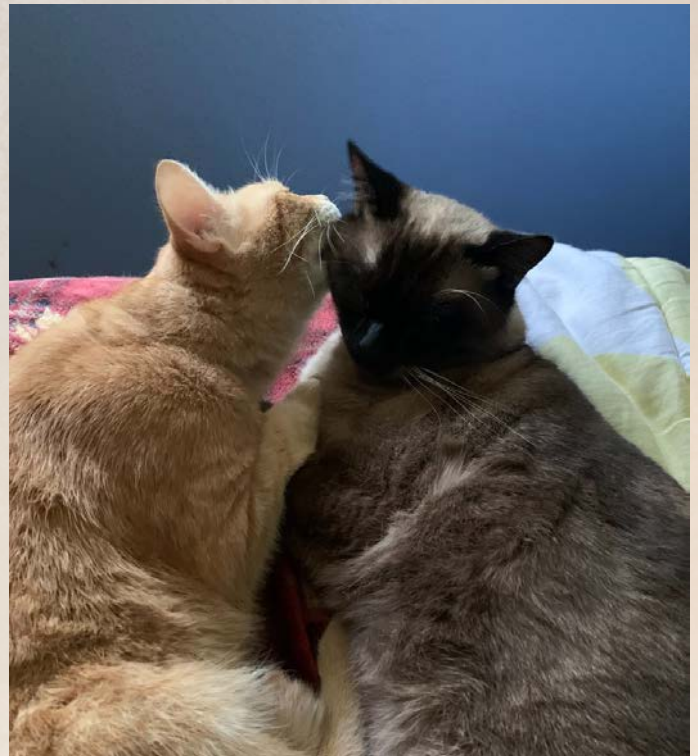

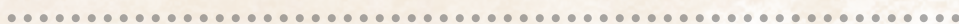
