### **SPOT SHRIMP COMMERCIAL OPENINGS**

**No scheduled openings currently**

### **SPOT SHRIMP SUBSISTENCE OPENINGS**

#### **Region 2 East**

**Catch Areas 26AE and 24B (see regulation maps for specific opened areas)**

Opens: Noon Friday, May 3

Closes: September 15, 2024, or when the tribal share is harvested, whichever comes first

- Permits are required for this fishery and available at the Fisheries office
- Subsistence limit: 20 pounds of whole shrimp per day
- Trap limits: 4 traps per tribal ID per day
- Permits will be given for 2 days at a time
- **All harvest must be reported to the Fisheries Office within 2 business days**

### **CLAM & OYSTER COMMERCIAL OPENINGS**

#### **1) Clam Dig Tuesday, July 2<sup>nd</sup> from 8:30 am to 12:30 pm**

**Groups:** **No Assigned Groups**  
**Location:** **Dyes Inlet**, Erlands Point EP46  
**Access:** Foot access available from 5087 Erlands Point Rd NW, walk north 0.4 mi. Do Not trespass on private upland property.  
**Buyer:** Buyer will purchase clams on the beach at the harvest site. Buyer will not provide bags.

*If you arrive after the start time you will not be allowed to dig. Approximately 4,000 pounds available.*

#### **2) Clam Dig Wednesday, July 3<sup>rd</sup> from 9:00 am to 1:00 pm**

**Groups:** **No Assigned Groups**  
**Location:** **Dyes Inlet**, Erlands Point EP34  
**Access:** Foot access available from 5087 Erlands Point Rd NW, walk north 0.55 mi. or access from Purser residence, walk north. Do Not trespass on private upland property.  
**Buyer:** Buyer will purchase clams on the beach at the harvest site. Buyer will not provide bags.

*If you arrive after the start time you will not be allowed to dig. Approximately 4,000 pounds available.*

### **SUBSISTENCE CLAMS AND OYSTERS OPENINGS**

The following beaches are open for all oysters and clams, **except cockles**:

- Jeff Head Beach
- East Indianola Beach
- Tribal Center Beach **Closed for Oysters**
- Clam Island (Dyes Inlet)

**Opened to all Bivalves including cockles**

- Anna Smith Children's Park
- Fay Bainbridge State Park
- South Pt. Monroe
- Shine Tidelands
- Wolfe Property State Park
- Illahee State Park

Harvesters must report totals to the fisheries office within 72 hours of harvest. Permits are required for ceremonial harvests.

**GEODUCK OPENINGS:**

Open for contracted Suquamish Seafood divers, as scheduled by Suquamish Seafood.

**CATCH REPORTING:**

All fishers must report all subsistence and commercial landings on a Treaty Indian Fish Receiving Ticket using a valid Suquamish fisherman's I.D. card.
