LEGAL GEAR: Gillnets/Beach seines:
Drift Nets/Set Nets; Max. mesh size of 5 inches, Max. length of 600 FT. Minimum Distance of 150 FT. between adjacent nets.
Beach Seines; Max. length of 600 FT.
Hook and Line (up to six (6) hooks per vessel)

FISHING SCHEDULE:
OPEN: 7 AM Friday, September 27, 2024
Will remain open 7 Days/Week until further notice

COMMENTS: Harvestable Coho salmon.

AREA RESTRICTIONS:
Area 10 waters: The greater Pt Madison area on-reservation are now open (PT Jefferson to Pt Monroe through Agate Pass).
The waters within Miller Bay shall remain closed

Area 10E waters: On Reservation south and west of the Agate Pass Bridge and north of a line from Battle Point due west to landfall shall be open. Liberty Bay west of Lemolo remains closed.
