

**2024-25 ANNUAL FRESHWATER REGULATIONS**

July 1, 2024 REGULATION # 25-04F

**INTRODUCTION:**

The following regulations pertain to Suquamish freshwater recreational fisheries within the Usual and Accustomed fishing areas of the Suquamish Tribe. Regulations and seasons are set by WA Dept. of Fish and Wildlife Game Fish and Food Fish (2024/2025 Pamphlet) for Westside lakes and rivers west of the Cascade Divide.

**OTHER RESTRICTIONS:**

1. PARTICIPATING FISHERS MUST UTILIZE THE SPORT FISHING RULES PAMPHLET PERTAINING TO THAT CURRENT FISHING YEAR PUBLISHED BY THE WASHINGTON DEPARTMENT OF FISH & WILDLIFE FOR REGULATIONS REGARDING SPECIFICS ON FISHING AREAS, SPECIES, LIMITS, AND GEAR
2. FISHERS ARE REQUIRED TO BE IN POSSESSION OF THEIR TREATY INDIAN IDENTIFICATION CARD AND HAVE A CURRENT FINFISH STICKER
3. PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 14. ALL CATCH MUST BE REPORTED TO THE FISHERIES DEPARTMENT.
