#### MARINE FISH / SHELLFISH HARVEST AREAS AND QUOTAS:

Combined tribal harvest will be managed so as not to exceed the amounts assigned to the specific areas as listed below:

**District 1** (San Juan Island Region) Areas 20A, 20B, 21A, 21B, 22A, 22B Harvest target: Approximately 110,141 pounds

**District 2-1** (Strait of Juan de Fuca Region West) Areas 23A North and east of a line drawn from McCurdy Point to the north tip of Protection Island to Trial Island Harvest target: Approximately 48,600 pounds

**District 2-2** (Strait of Juan de Fuca Region East) Areas 23B, 25A, 25B, 25C, and 25D, North and east of a line drawn from McCurdy Point to the north tip of Protection Island to Trial Island Harvest target: 39,536 pounds

**District 3** (Central Sound) Areas 26B, 26C, 26AW, 26AE, and 24B, south of a line drawn from Camano Head to Mission Point 2,500 pounds available for exploratory fisheries use only

## **EXPECTED EFFORT**: 1 to 3 boats in all areas combined

## SUBSISTENCE LIMIT: 5 Sea Cucumbers a day

## **CLOSED AREAS:**

## **Districts 1 and 2 (San Juans and Strait)**

- Those waters of San Juan Channel and Upright Channel within the following lines: north and west of a line from the northernmost point of Turn Island to Flat Point on Lopez Island and thence projected from Flat Point true west to Shaw Island, north of a line projected from the northernmost point of Turn Island true west to San Juan Island, west of a line from Neck Point on Shaw Island to Steep Point on Orcas Island, and south of a line from Steep Point on Orcas Island.
- Those waters of Haro Strait north of a line projected due west from the southernmost point of Cattle Point on San Juan Island to the international border and south of a line projected due west from a point one-quarter mile north of Lime Kiln Light on San Juan Island to the international border.
- Argyle Lagoon: Those University of Washington-owned tidelands and all bedlands enclosed by the inner spit of Argyle Lagoon on San Juan Island.



#### CATCH REPORTING:

All fishers must report all subsistence or commercial landings on a Treaty Indian Fish Receiving Ticket using a valid Suquamish fisherman's I.D. card.

#### OTHER REQUIREMENTS:

Harvester must have current Suquamish Tribal ID card with current shellfish sticker. All harvest is pursuant to rules and regulations included in the 2018-19 Puget Sound Sea Cucumber Harvest Management Plan.

#### **DIVE REQUIREMENTS:**

All divers and dive vessels shall adhere to OSHA commercial diving operation standards and the Suquamish Safe Dives Manual.
